1 Corinthians 13:5 does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, <u>is not provoked</u>, thinks no evil; NKJV

1 Corinthians 13:5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, <u>is not</u> <u>easily provoked</u>, thinketh no evil; KJV

1 Corinthians 13:5 It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, <u>it is not easily</u> <u>angered</u>, it keeps no record of wrongs. NIV

God Is Not Easily Provoked

Psalm 103:8 The LORD is merciful and gracious, <u>Slow to anger</u>, and abounding in mercy.

Psalm 145:8 The LORD is gracious and <u>full of compassion, Slow to anger</u> and great in mercy.

2 Corinthians 10:1 Now I Paul myself beseech you <u>by the meekness and gentleness</u> <u>of Christ</u>, who in presence am base among you, but being absent am bold toward you:

Matthew 27:11-14 Now Jesus stood before the governor. And the governor asked Him, saying, "Are You the King of the Jews?"

Jesus said to him, "It is as you say." And <u>while He was being accused by the chief</u> <u>priests and elders, He answered nothing</u>. Ecclesiastes 7:9 <u>Do not hasten in your spirit to be angry</u>, <u>For anger rests in the bosom of fools.</u>

Proverbs 27:4 Wrath is cruel, and anger is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy?

The Wisdom And Strength Of Being Not Easily Provoked

James 3:13 <u>Who is wise and understanding among you</u>? Let him show by good conduct that <u>his works are done in the meekness of wisdom</u>.

Proverbs 14:29 <u>He who is slow to wrath has great understanding</u>, But he who is impulsive exalts folly.

Proverbs 16:32 <u>He who is slow to anger is better than the mighty</u>, <u>And he who rules</u> <u>his spirit</u> than he who takes a city

Proverbs 15:18 A wrathful man stirs up strife, <u>But he who is slow to anger allays</u> <u>contention.</u>

1 Peter 2:20 For what credit is it if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? <u>But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this is</u> <u>commendable before God</u>.

Proverbs 19:11 <u>The discretion of a man makes him slow to anger</u>, And his glory is to overlook a transgression.

The Action And Fruit Of Not Being Easily Provoked

Colossians 3:12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, <u>humbleness of mind, meekness</u>, longsuffering;

2 Timothy 2:24-26 <u>And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle</u> to all, able to teach, patient, <u>in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God</u> <u>perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth</u>, and <u>that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil</u>, having been taken captive by him to do his will.

Matthew 5:44 But I say to you, love your enemies, <u>bless those who curse you</u>, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you,

Romans 12:14 Bless those who persecute you: bless and do not curse

Proverbs 15:1 <u>A soft answer turns away wrath</u>, But a harsh word stirs up anger.
